

APRIL 27, 2026 MEETING MINUTES

1. Call meeting to order at 7:00pm. Pledge of allegiance was recited
2. Approval of minutes from March meeting. Motion made by Kopf/Stahmann, carried 3-0.
3. Public Comments - (Please note this is the Town Board's monthly business meeting, not a public hearing. People wishing to speak on any item not on the agenda should present their comments now under this "Public Comments" agenda item. In addition, although the Board can receive comments on matters not included on this agenda, it cannot discuss or take action on these matters.) 4. Reports:
 - a. Chairman Dave Jahns – Jahns reported complaints on ditches flooding, culvert washed out on Sales Road, many branches hanging down, All did BOR Training, meet with the County and went over Olden Road bids, meet with the Fire Chief and Brain with Rural Mutal Insurance, complaints on blighted properties.
 - b. Supervisor Joe Kopf -Kopf reported meeting with the County, attending the BOR Training, special thanks to Charlie and Cheryl on all the budget work and what all goes into it, nice to see it first hand, Proud to be a part of it.
 - c. Supervisor Todd Stahmann- Stahmann reported a couple of phone calls, also attended the same
 - d. Clerk Cheryl Pionke – Clerk Pionke filed the ARPA report online, submitted the DNR Recycling grant, worked on the Form CT that is due in a few weeks, attended the insurance meeting, BOR Training,
 - e. Treasurer Vickie Michels- GC\$23,509.07, MMS\$151,727.64, ARPA\$19,611.10, SF\$1,004.69, EF\$180,929.80, OR\$232,109.86, TC\$411,792.20
Vickie Michels assisted with voting, day over all went very well.
 - f. Plan Commission-Stahmann reported on a few concept plans, Madigan property on Town Hall Rd looking to split off 5 acres of residential lot, also talked over Dave Brenner on County Rd I , Krista was also here from Cedar Corp telling the Town what they are able and not able do, first meeting with Krista went very well, lots of information.
 - g. Building Permit Officer-Weinke reported 3 permits this month, have 2 more coming in. One for a shed extension, one for a roof.
 - h. Town Highway - Pionke reported fixing signs, will need to order a few signs, speed limits signs, stop signs, stop ahead sign, started some patch work on Olden Road, will be replacing a culvert on Sales Rd, asking how to notify, Dave suggested sending out a letter or stopping out by each house, working in the shop and getting the mowing tractor ready for the mowing season, received a bunch of calls about water, Bulky Drop Off day was a success, some people were from out of the Town, had 8 full dumpsters picked up by Gueilgs.
 - i. Fire Department- Pionke reported 9 calls, line down, vehicle on fire, 3 mabas calls, 1 brush fire, 1 carbon monoxide, got the Brush Truck back, cleaned the fire house for

Easter Egg Hunt and for sheepsheads night, at the last fire chiefs meetings talked about forming a committee to assist with some grant writing, Completed hose testing on April 20th.

- j. First Responders- Leichtfuss reported 3 calls, Easter Egg Hunt went well, call came in before the hunt started, renewal is due in June for the EMR's getting ready to submit to state.
5. Action on Resolution 04272026 approving the jurisdictional transfer of Olden Road from County Trunk Highway C to State Highway 26 in the Towns of Eldorado and Rosendale to Fond du Lac County and authorize the proper county officials to sign agreements needed to accomplish the transfer. Motion made by Jahns/Stahmann, carried 3-0.
6. Update on Fire Truck purchase from Van Dyne Fire Department. Clerk Pionke spoke with Mick, neither Towns have signed contract, will be put on there upcoming agenda.
7. Update on blighted properties. Kopf said that letter was sent and he has not been contacted yet, Clerk reported on a few properties in Townline Circle.
8. Update on Olden Road. Board spoke about meeting with the County and Town of Rosendale, went through the bids, went with lowest bid James Paterson and Sons.
9. Discussion and Action on Harter's Lakeside Garbage and Recycling Contract August 1 2026-July 31, 2031. Motion made by Kopf/Stahmann, carried 3-0.
10. Discussion and action on moving May's meeting due to Memorial Day. May 18th, 2026, Motion made by Jahns/Kopf, carried 3-0.
