

JANUARY 26, 2026 MEETING MINUTES

1. Call meeting to order at 7:01pm. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
2. Approval of minutes from December meeting. Motion made by Stahmann/Jahns, carried 2-0.

4. Reports:
 - a. Chairman Dave Jahns – Jahns reported phone calls about wrecked garbage cans, also had the septic system put in, calls about building permits and land use, also attended a meeting in Oakfield.
 - b. Supervisor Joe Kopf – No report
 - c. Supervisor Todd Stahmann- Stahmann reported been getting compliments on new plow truck.
 - d. Clerk Cheryl Pionke - Pionke reported finished up tax exemption property forms, still trying to get year end completed, working on W2's, W3's, WT7's. Still need to get 1099's completed.
 - e. Treasurer Vickie Michels- GC\$15,140.44, MM\$184,750.66, ARPA\$19,574.88, SF\$1,004.69, EF\$338,782.54, OR\$232,109.86, TC\$757,576.64
 - f. Plan Commission- Stahmann reported one concept plan reviewed, had not heard anything from Cedar Corp, we do have information now, will be at next plan commission next month, Borski is looking for old survey from residents, still waiting on DATCP recertification.
 - g. Building Permit Officer- Weinke reported 2 building permits, one bathroom remodel and one hot water heater replacement, working with a few currently right now.
 - h. Town Highway - Pionke reported busy month plowing snow, new truck is up in De Pere getting lights and on spot chains on, put a new seat in the Ford truck, Generator will be tested shortly, did some road patching before the snow, will need to cut a tree down on Townline Circle, new truck still needs lettering and a radio put in yet, had a few tvs dropped and cell phones, did pick up 30 tires in the ditch, on Lincoln Road, took to American

 - j. First Responders- Leichtfuss reported 2 medical calls, 1 accident call on 41. Tomorrow is the Friends and Family of Eldorado meeting at 6pm at the Fire House.
5. Update on ATV/UTV routes. Jahns and Pionke spoke on the meeting in Oakfield. Pionke advised application is ready to go to the County with the check. Will provide an update after the highway meeting.
6. Discussion and Action on adding a water softener at the Community Center. Pionke spoke on the quote from Abel, we have very hard water here. Motion made by Jahns to install water softener by Abels, not to exceed \$2500, seconded by Stahmann, carried 2-0.
