

MARCH 23, 2026 MEETING MINUTES

1. Call meeting to order at 7:01pm. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
2. Approval of minutes from February meeting. Motion made by Kopf/Stahmann, carried 3-0.
3. Public Comments - (Please note this is the Town Board's monthly business meeting, not a public hearing. People wishing to speak on any item not on the agenda should present their comments now under this "Public Comments" agenda item. In addition, although the Board can receive comments on matters not included on this agenda, it cannot discuss or take action on these matters.) (Each commenter will be limited to a total of 3 minutes.)
4. Reports:
 - a. Chairman Dave Jahns – Jahns reported attended the FDL Towns association meeting, County Exec spoke on the campus and will be moving forward with that, Sherriff Waldschmidt gave a presentation on the Police body cams, also talked about the jail expansion, no definite answers at this time, put another sex offender house out by the Highway Dept, this is house number 3. Jahnke talked over road projects coming up in Fond du Lac. Took a few phone calls about down trees, plowing on Coyne Rd and a call about accurate call letters. Also got a call from Ben with Gremmer about the road bids and have not had time to talk to Jahnke yet.
 - b. Supervisor Joe Kopf – Kopf reported had a few extra meetings, attended the Plan Commission meeting and had a lot of information, was very well received. Had talked with Mike before the storm and had a plan in place.
 - c. Supervisor Todd Stahmann- Stahmann reported also attended the Asphalt meeting earlier this month, will talk more about the Plan Commission later on, had calls about the roads and being plowed.
 - d. Clerk Cheryl Pionke - Pionke reported got all the absentee ballots out last week, started working on the financial statement, form CT, and also the insurance audit that is coming up. Will be doing an election training on April 1st to get ready for the April 7th Election.
 - e. Treasurer Vickie Michels- GC\$28,869.16, MM\$151,631.05, ARPA\$19,598.61, SF\$1,004.69, EF\$180,929.80, OR\$232,109.86, TC\$420,617.28
 - f. Plan Commission- Stahmann reported a discussion on how we are going to proceed with Cedar Corp, Krista will be at the next Plan Commission in April, had a concept plan about storage units going on up Lincoln Rd and Townline Rd, had a few residents show up who brought up valid concerns.
 - g. Building Permit Officer- Weinke reported 2 building permits, one for a new shed, one with solar panels.
 - h. Town Highway - Pionke reported had some issues, will need chains on the back of the Ford truck for more traction, will need to fix a few roads due to plow damage, a few road signs and posts will need to be replaced, will need to have a plan in place going forward, many trees hanging over on Sales Road. Generator is up and working.
 - i. Fire Department- Borski reported 2 accident calls, 1 mutual aid call with Van Dyne, had hose testing this month, also just finished up there FDL Fire Chiefs Bowling weekend. Also talked on the new radios that are coming out. Track Machine is having some maintenance done on it. Also will be meeting with Insurance Guy next month.
 - j. First Responders- Leichtfuss reported 2 accidents calls, 6 medical calls. Easter Egg Hunt April 4th, Registration starts at 9 and hunt starts at 10 at the Eldorado Fire House.

5. Discussion and Possible Action on Town Board resolution supporting a comprehensive and sustainable transportation funding solution. Motion made by Stahmann/Kopf, carried 3-0.
6. Discussion and Action on Weed Ordinance being posted on behalf of Wisconsin Towns Association. Jahns made motion to propose resolution to post the weed notice on the Towns of Eldorado behalf, seconded by Kopf, carried 3-0.
7. Discussion and Action on Lawn Bids. Clerk provided 2024/2025 comparison. Kopf provided all that went into making this switch. Motion made by Kopf/ Stahmann, carried 3-0.
8. Update on Support Letter sent for Internet Complaints from residents. Clerk Pionke provided that a letter of support was sent, received a response within 2 days and also spoke with Mark from the PSC. Provided some information on what is coming.
9. Update on Fire Truck purchase from Van Dyne Fire Department. Clerk Pionke stated she has spoken with Mick Becker from Van Dyne, Black Wolf has signed the contract, Friendship forgot to place on the meeting this month, so it will be going on there April meeting.
10. Discussion and Action on planned maintenance agreement for the Generator at the Town Garage from Total Energy Systems, LLC. Discussion was had. Motion was made to go with Total Energy Systems LLC annual maintenance 1-3 years, ATS Minor PM 1-3 years and then a 2 hour load bank test 1-3 years, Kopf seconded, carried 3-0.
11. Discussion and Possible Action on blighted property. Discussion was had, Motion was made to have the Clerk send an email to Matt and have them start the process, carried 3-0.
12. Questions or Comments on Agenda items - Individuals wishing to speak on any agenda item discussed above should present their comments now under this "Public Comments" agenda item. Each commenter will be limited to a total of three consecutive minutes under this agenda item.
