 - b. Supervisor Dave Jahns- couple calls of garbage blowing around outside the garbage trucks, permit wise it's been quiet.
 - c. Supervisor Bill Averbeck- met with farmer who was driving in ditches, farmer agreed to put in bigger culverts.
 - d. Clerk Cheryl Pionke – no report
 - e. Treasurer Heather VandeBerg-GC\$15,631.99, MM \$110,874.69, TX\$813.20, NE\$77,169.75
 - f. Plan Commission- Schultz CUP is moving along, Rabe's CSM got moved to January meeting. Substation is in the works; they will have 2 years to get it built. Jenna talked in length about the application process.
 - g. Town Highway- been cutting trees on Marsh Rd, doing some maintenance on trucks, put up some snow fence.
 - h. Fire Department- 1 car fire, 2 accidents, still operating as normal with truck inspection and training.
 - i. First Responders- 2 car accidents, 1 medical call, 5 people completed the EMR class and will be taking the state test.
4. Discussion on Farmland Preservation Act- went over email from Matt, comment was made that there really is no advantage to the Farmland Preservation Act. Lots of discussion.
